ORAL & MAXILLOFACIAL PATHOLOGY AND ORAL MICROBIOLOGY

The Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Pathology and Oral Microbiology is an integral part of Dr Harvansh Singh Judge Institute of Dental Sciences & Hospital which is dedicated to advancing knowledge in diagnosing, managing, and preventing oral diseases. Through its comprehensive academic programs, clinical services, research, and dedicated faculty and staff, the department is committed to improving the oral health of our community and advancing the science of oral pathology and microbiology.

Mission: To advance knowledge in oral pathology and oral microbiology and provide exceptional education, research, and clinical care to improve the oral health of our community and beyond.

Vision: To be a leading center for oral pathology and oral microbiology, renowned for our innovative research, groundbreaking clinical applications, and exceptional student training.

The department offers a Master's program since 2017 (with an intake of 3 Postgraduates per academic session) to prepare students for careers in oral health care. It also offers clinical services for Oral Biopsy and Diagnosis by providing a definitive diagnosis of oral lesions, including benign and malignant tumors, and Maxillofacial Pathology by diagnosing diseases affecting the jaws, facial bones, and surrounding tissues. The department is also actively engaged in a wide range of research projects, focusing on improving the diagnostic modalities for oral squamous cell carcinoma; age and gender estimation employing various odontometric and other oral parameters; studying the role of oral microorganisms in oral pathological diseases; and developing new diagnostic tools and technologies for early detection and accurate diagnosis of oral diseases.

DEPARTMENT OF ORTHODONTICS & DENTOFACIAL ORTHOPEDICS

There should be nothing artificial about your smile and orthodontics along with dentofacial orthopedics does the same. The Department of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopaedics, of Dr Harvansh Singh Judge Institute of Dental Sciences & Hospital is one of the best Orthodontic departments in the tricity area of Chandigarh, Mohali and Panchkula. One of the major difference viz a viz other dental departments is that teeth are not seen as individuals units but as an integral part of the jaw and face scientifically and integral part of personality of an individual, socially.

The department is providing treatment at a very nominal cost despite being located near the heart of the city beautiful Chandigarh. It caters to the patients having problems of irregular teeth, crooked teeth, spacing between teeth, bad bite, cleft lip and palateand also patients having skeletal problems. The department is offering orthodontic treatment by incorporating all the latest methods / techniques available such as PEA (Pre-adjusted Edgewise appliance), Ceramic (aesthetic braces), Self-ligating systems, Clear Aligners therapy (CAT) Lingual (invisible braces), Micro implants and correction of Jaw problems by growth modulation techniques and/or orthographic surgeries as per the individual need.

The department is catering to the patients coming from periphery of tricity area of Chandigarh, Panchkula and Mohali i.e as far as 30 km radius of Chandigarh. Further, the department has many outstation patient as far as Delhi, Himachal, Haryana and Punjab. At present, the department has more than 1000 running cases of comprehensive orthodontic treatment. Recently department has seen a surge in adult orthodontic cases being reported which speaks volumes about the awareness being present in the surrounding areas.

The department is well equipped with 29 ultra-modern electronically operated dental chairs with light cure units and scalers attached. The department has Hydro soldering unit and pressure moulding machine for super specialty work.

The department started post-graduation (MDS) in the year 2015 with intake of three students every year. The department has well equipped Cephalometric-tracing area along with Nemoceph software for treatment planning, fully audiovisual ready seminar room cum department library, PG common room and systematic record maintenance zone including readily retrievable digital photographs, study models and radiographs of the patients. Being part of Panjab University the students can also, take advantage of Interdisciplinary research by collaborating with various other departments of universities more so by utilizing state of art equipment and infrastructure available pan university. Further, the department is providing teaching/clinical training to 100 BDS undergraduate students every year, for which the department has best of infrastructure (spacious &well-equipped lecture theatres, orthodontic laboratories and library with internet facility) in the entire region. Lectures are taken with Audio visual aids and constant encouragement for participation in projects pertaining to the subject elsewhere.

The department faculty has high level of publications profile including a patent and copyright grant from Government of India. DEPARTMENT OF PERIODONTICS

The Department of Periodontics at Panjab University has separate undergraduate and postgraduate sections equipped with modern dental chairs fitted with ultrasonic scalers as per Dental Council of India guidelines. Undergraduate students are trained with skills to render non-surgical and preventive periodontal procedures and are introduced to surgical periodontal procedures by observing and assisting as procedures are being performed. Postgraduate students are given opportunity to learn and master a variety of surgical clinical procedures. Practical training in various implant systems and clinical exposure to use of lasers and microsurgical Equipments is being imparted as part of the MDS curriculum.

Key Features

- Advanced surgical equipments like Laser unit, microsurgical unit, electrocautery unit, and centrifuge to procure PRF, implant unit are the additional facilities available in the department.
- Advanced research facilities like PCR, anaerobic chamber, ELISA, CBCT, systems are also available at the institutional level. Few more sophisticated research equipment(Gel Electrophoresis, with power pack, Gradient PCR unit) has been sanctioned to the department from central grants viz SERB, which are further value additions to the institute as a whole.
- The institute is a member of 'CRICK' unit of Panjab university and has multiple inter institute collaborations including IMTECH,PGIMER,GMCH-32 with ongoing projects from Periodontology department. It is one of the spokes in the MHRD sectioned "Design Innovation Centre" of university, with the focused research on the development and testing of biomedical devices. Additionally there are in house inter departmental collaborations with the microbiology, biotechnology, biochemistry and biophysics departments of Panjab University to provide a broader research avenues.
- An MOU with the Central Instruments Laboratory (CIL) and Sophisticated Analytical Instrumentation Facility (SAIF) provides an in-house platform for conducting TEM, SEM, Mass Spectrometry, NMR, electron microscope, and Field Emission Scanning Electron Microscope.
- The department is credit with research funding worth 26,655,000 /- from various research project grants, which sums to equivalent to approximately 90% of the total funding of the institute.

Faculty

The entire faculty (7 members) is involved in teaching undergraduate and post graduate students. The faculty is highly experienced with an experience over 15-25 years along with eight postgraduates at present. Currently, two faculty members have completed PhD course at UGC approved universities . Faculty members are also members of board of studies and various college committees. Some of them are examiners for national and international universities. Many are active members of ISP holding key posts presently or in the past. Two of the faculty members are fellows of International College of Dentists. The faculty members have, in their credit, more than 190 publications in various national and International indexed journals with high impact Factor. Many of the departmental projects have been funded by Government bodies viz ICMR, SERB, DST and industry grants from oral health care sectors e.g waterpik, Orthogen. Some of the areas of research interest are:

- Regeration of soft and hard tissues
- Periodontal Medicine
- Microbiology
- Implants
- Periopathogenesis at molecular level

- Local drug Delivery
- Preventive and nonsurgical periodontal Therapy
- Perio-aesthetic surgeries

A no. of events and conferences has been arranged at the departmental level from time to time. Most recently, the department has organized 47th ISP National Conference,1-3 December,2023 at GNDU auditorium, Amritsar. The conference hosted more than 1500 delegates from all over the country, with scientific deliberations from 5 International Periodntology Associations being the highlight of the scientific event. A few important ones are 22nd ISP PG national convention 2022, Chandigarh, 37th National Annual ISP conference at Shimla, Indo-US Bilateral workshop on 21st Century Developments in Bone Regeneration, CHASCON 2023, National Seminar on Clinical Dentistry (an annual institutional event), 2nd ISP Colloquium 2015, ISP Perio Integrate with hands-on workshop on Implants, Lasers and Peizosurgery. The department of periodontology, in collaboration with department of Public health Dentistry has been actively involved in conducting special events like Oral Hygiene day, Oral Health day, Dentsist's day etc.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The admission to MDS course shall be open to candidates who have qualified NEET-MDS 2024 and are eligible as per eligibility criteria for NEET-MDS 2024 laid down in Information Bulletin for National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test-MDS for admission to MDS course 2024.
- 2. As per Dental Council of India guidelines, the minimum percentile of marks to be eligible for admission to postgraduate dental courses shall be 50% percentile for General Category & NRI candidates, 45% percentile for Person with Disability (PwD) and 40% percentile for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/ Backward Classes (BC).
- 3. Counseling / Admission shall be conducted by the Admission Committee constituted by the Panjab University for this purpose.
- 4. Candidates cannot claim a seat/admission on the basis of the NEET-MDS-2024 rank alone. Eligibility of a candidate for admission against any Post Graduate seat will be determined by the Admission Committee, as per rules and regulations laid down by the Panjab University & DCI from time to time. The eligibility shall also be based on other documents as specified in the check list on page No. 28.
- 5. In case any candidate is found to have furnished false information or certificate, etc. or is found to have withheld or concealed information in his/her Admission Form, he/she shall be debarred from admission.
- 6. In case any candidate surrenders a seat, he/she will not be eligible to attend subsequent admission counselings for the MDS course in the University in the same year.
- 7. All eligible candidates including own merit candidates from reserved categories will be considered for admission against general category seats according to their rank/merit in the combined list (as per merit criteria for General Category), in addition to the category/categories they have applied for.
- 8. For claims on reserved seats/categories wherever applicable, the candidates must support their claim by bringing original documents on the date of couselling (point No. 6 of the schedule) self-attested photocopy of appropriate certificate(s)/documents issued by competent authority as per specimen given in Annexures to this Prospectus.
- 9. The candidate shall not be allowed to make any change(s) in the Category as well as in the Online Application Form, once submitted, by way of any

addition/ deletion/ alteration/ amendment etc. of any type under any circumstance.

10. Candidate with disability, i.e., Person with Disability (PwD) shall be considered for admission as per rules and regulations specified by Dental Council of India as appended below:-

"5% seats of the annual sanctioned intake capacity shall be filled up by candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs in between 50% to 70%.

Provided that in case any seat in this 5% quota remains unfilled on account of unavailability of candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% then any such unfilled seat in this 5% quota shall be filled up by persons with locomotory disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% before they are included in the annual sanctioned seats for General Category candidates".

11. Eligibility Criteria for NRI Students

Only NEET (PG)-2024 qualified candidates (not less than 50th Percentile) can apply for admission against NRI Category seats for admission year 2024.

A foreign national may seek admission in MDS being offered by the University through the International Students Office under any of the following categories-

- (i) Candidates with nomination / sponsorship by any foreign State, Embassy or authority in India under a Study in India / Exchange Programme, etc.
- (ii) Foreign nationals or their wards who are self-financed students (not seeking admission through a mode as mentioned in (i) above).
- (iii) Non- resident Indians or their Wards (not seeking admission through a mode as mentioned in (i) above).

The definition of the terms, "Foreign Nationals, Non-resident Indians and Wards" be considered as under:-

- 1. Foreign Nationals: Foreign Nationals holding passports issued by foreign countries including people of Indian origin who have acquired the nationality of foreign countries are included as foreign students. Provided any subsequent changes in the definition as may be notified by the Government of India shall have the same latest meaning respectively assigned to them. The other expressions not defined herein shall have the meaning as may be assigned in any subsequent notification of the Government of India.
- 2. Non-resident Indians: A person shall be deemed to be Non-resident Indian for seeking admission in Panjab University if he/she fulfils the criterion (as amended from time to time) for status of NRI under Income Tax Act, 1961, in the year in which he/she seeks admission in Panjab University.

As per Income Tax Act, 1961 the present criterion for determination of status of NRI is as follows:-

'Non-resident Indian' is an individual who is a citizen of India or a person of Indian origin and who is not a resident of India. Thus, in order to determine whether an

Individual is a non-resident Indian or not, his residential status is required to be determined under Section 6. As per Section 6 of the Income-tax Act, an individual is said to be non-resident in India if he is not a resident in India and an individual is deemed to be resident in India in any previous year if he satisfies any of the following conditions:-

- (i) If he is in India for a period of 182 days or more during the previous year; or
- (ii) If he is in India for a period of 60 days or more during the previous year and 365 days or more during 4 years immediately preceding the previous year.
- However, condition No. (ii) does not apply where an individual being citizen of India or a person of Indian origin, who being outside India, comes on a visit to India during the previous year.
- A person shall be deemed to be of Indian origin if he, or either of his parents or any of his parents or any of his grand parents, was born in undivided India.
- 3. Wards of Foreign Nationals and NRIs:
 - A student who seeks admission as a ward of Foreign National or Non-resident Indian should be in a first degree / blood relationship with foreign national or Non-resident Indian. The term first degree / blood relationship includes
- (a) spouse
- (b) children (natural / adopted / foster)
- (c) real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and real aunt
- (d) real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt
- (e) father and mother of father i.e. grand father and grand-mother
- (f) Father and mother of mother i.e. maternal grand-father and maternal grand-mother
- (g) first degree-paternal and maternal cousins.

Following documents are to be attached with the application:

- a. Affidavits and undertaking (Appendix IV)
- b. Photocopy of sponsor Passport

Eligibility and Admission Criteria:

- (i) The students who will be admitted against the NRI quota should have the basic qualification fixed by the Dental Council of India for admission in Dental courses.
- (ii) A candidate once admitted as NRI candidate in an undergraduate course shall be covered under the definition of NRI for subsequent admission to any course at Panjab University.
- (iii) NRI candidates shall have to comply with any other requirements prescribed by the Govt. of India and Panjab University from time to time.
- (iv) The Foreign Nationals and NRI candidates shall provide the following certificates / documents:-
- (a) The Foreign National and NRI students wishing to join MDS course of the Panjab University for the first time are required to obtain an eligibility certificate from the Deputy Registrar (General), Panjab University, Chandigarh or Academic Certificates of passing the qualifying or equivalent examination approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/ Commonwealth Universities/ International Association of Universities (IAU) as equivalent to the corresponding Indian Degrees/ Certificates.
- (b) The foreign students admitted are required to fill up Foreign Student Information

System (FSIS) Form complete in all respects, along with copies of passport and Visa and submit to the office of Dean International Students, Panjab University, Chandigarh. This form is an urgent requirement of the Foreign Registration Office (FRO), Sector-9, Chandigarh and the candidate has to report to the Foreign Registration Office (FRO) within fourteen days of arrival in Chandigarh, with the number generated after the online submission of this form. Foreign Students Information System (FSIS) is to be submitted by hand by the candidate and the FSIS No. will be issued by this Office personally to the students.

- (c) Foreign Students Welfare Fee @ Rs.1500/- per student. Each NRI/Foreign Student is required to submit the same in cash, which may be deposited with the 'Extension Counter, State Bank of India, Administrative Block, Panjab University, Chandigarh. Original Receipts of the fee deposited is to be submitted to the office of the Dean International Students along with Registration Form (To be submitted after Confirmation of Admission).
- (v) The seats of Foreign Nationals and NRI are "Inter-Changeable". That is, if sufficient numbers of eligible candidates are not available to fill up the seats of NRI, seats may be filled up from among the eligible candidates belonging to Foreign Nationals, and vice-versa. The conversion of seats shall be done after second counselling for NRI / Foreign National or after exhausting the waiting list of NRI / Foreign Nationals.

Candidates are advised to browse the website regularly for any announcements/changes and the Institute shall not be responsible for any fallout due to lack of information on the part of the candidate.
- 3. Candidates must retain the copy of Prospectus & Printed Application Form with them. They should carefully read the instructions, rules & regulations and comply with all instructions therein strictly.

The allotment of speciality to the applicants for admission, shall be made by the Admission Committee as per merit determined on the basis of NEET-MDS-2024 and the choice of the speciality opted by the candidate. The candidate must bring along all the original documents as well as a set of photocopies of all these aforementioned original documents.
- 5. The candidate should read the eligibility conditions/ criteria carefully. Just appearing in counseling does not entitle him/her for admission. The eligibility shall be determined by the Admission Committee on the basis of documents submitted by the candidate at the time of counseling. Those who are not eligible as per the decision of the committee will not be considered for admission. The candidates will appear in counseling at their own risk and responsibility. That is to say, if sufficient numbers of eligible candidates are not available to fill up the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes the same may be filled up from amongst the eligible candidates belonging to the Scheduled Tribes and vice-versa.
- 10. The seats of Foreign National and NRI are "Inter-Changeable". That is, if sufficient numbers of eligible candidates are not available to fill up the seat of NRI, seat may be filled up from among the eligible candidates belonging to Foreign Nationals, and vice-versa.
- 11. In case sufficient numbers of eligible candidates, belonging to Reserved Categories i.e. SC/ST/BC/PwD and NRI are not available, the vacant seats during the second counseling shall be transferred and filled from the General Category candidates on the basis of merit/rank obtained in NEET-MDS-2024.
- 12 Any seats which are made available due to up-gradation of already admitted candidates during 2nd counseling/MOP UP round will also be filled up through counseling of eligible candidates on the same date.

Important Admission Formalities

- 1. The candidates selected for admission will have to undergo medical examination by the constituted Medical Board on the same day or succeeding day of their selection to the course. Only those candidates who are found to be medically fit shall be granted admission.
- 2. The candidates, who do not appear before the Medical Board or are found to be medically unfit, shall not be allowed to join the course.
- 3. Fee is to be paid on the day of the counseling. The candidature of the eligible candidates, who do not deposit the prescribed fees in full, shall stand automatically cancelled and vacancies so caused shall be offered to the candidates next in order of merit on the same day/ subsequent counseling. No correspondence or appeal in this connection will be entertained by the Admission Committee.
- 4. Admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with eligibility criteria and rules mentioned in this Prospectus and as per existing rules of Panjab University and Dental Council of India. - 2. Fee shall be refunded by all HEIs to an eligible student within fifteen days from the date of receiving a written application from him/her in this regrd.
- 3. Refund forms will be available at the P.U. Website i.e. http://forms.puchd.ac.in (the photocopy of bank passbook of the candidate only be attached)
- 4. But in all other Cases of the students continuing their studies, the Library Security will be refunded if he/she will apply within six months from the date of leaving the Department/Institute/Centre/Regional Centre after completing the full course of studies.

II. Refund of Fee Rules of NRI Category and Foreign Nationals

In case, the candidate is admitted in the Foreign/NRI category and leaves the course & the seat vacated by a candidate is filled by granting admission to another applicant against the vacated seat, the tuition fee may be refunded to the person after deduction of 10% of the tuition fee as administrative charges. In case a seat vacated by such a candidate is not filled, the tuition fee may be refunded after deduction of 25% of the tuition fee as administrative charges.
