ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The admission to MDS course shall be open to candidates who have qualified NEET-MDS 2025 and are eligible as per eligibility criteria for NEET-MDS 2025 laid down in Information Bulletin for National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test-MDS for admission to MDS course 2025.
2. As per Dental Council of India guidelines, the minimum percentile of marks to be eligible for admission to postgraduate dental courses shall be 50% percentile for General Category & NRI candidates, 45% percentile for Person with Disability (PwD) and 40% percentile for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/ Backward Classes (BC).
3. Counseling / Admission shall be conducted by the Admission Committee constituted by the Panjab University for this purpose.
4. Candidates cannot claim a seat/admission on the basis of the NEET-MDS-2025 rank alone. Eligibility of a candidate for admission against any Post Graduate seat will be determined by the Admission Committee, as per rules and regulations laid down by the Panjab University & DCI from time to time. The eligibility shall also be based on other documents as specified in the check list on page No. 20.
5. In case any candidate is found to have furnished false information or certificate, etc. or is found to have withheld or concealed information in his/her Admission Form, he/she shall be debarred from admission.
6. In case any candidate surrenders a seat, he/she will not be eligible to attend subsequent admission counselings for the MDS course in the University in the same year.
7. All eligible candidates including own merit candidates from reserved categories will be considered for admission against general category seats according to their rank/merit in the combined list (as per merit criteria for General Category), in addition to the category/categories they have applied for.
8. For claims on reserved seats/categories wherever applicable, the candidates must support their claim by bringing original documents on the day of reporting (as per point No. 7, 12, 17 & 22 of the schedule) and self-attested photocopy of appropriate certificate(s)/ documents issued by competent authority as per specimen given in Annexures to this Prospectus.
9. **The candidate shall not be allowed to make any change(s) in the Category as well as in the Online Application Form, once submitted, by way of any addition/ deletion/ alteration/ amendment etc. of any type under any**

circumstance.

10. Candidate with disability, i.e., Person with Disability (PwD) shall be considered for admission as per rules and regulations specified by Dental Council of India as appended below:-

“5% seats of the annual sanctioned intake capacity shall be filled up by candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs in between 50% to 70%.

Provided that in case any seat in this 5% quota remains unfilled on account of unavailability of candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% then any such unfilled seat in this 5% quota shall be filled up by persons with locomotory disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% before they are included in the annual sanctioned seats for General Category candidates”.

11. Eligibility Criteria for NRI Students

Only NEET (MDS)-2025 qualified candidates (not less than 50th Percentile) can apply for admission against NRI Category seats for admission year 2025.

A foreign national may seek admission in MDS being offered by the University through Office of the Dean International Students, Panjab University, Chandigarh as per the guidelines/ terms & Conditions available at the website of <https://www.dis.puchd.ac.in/> provided that such candidates should be NEET-MDS-2025 qualified.

Notwithstanding any conditions laid down at <https://www.dis.puchd.ac.in> if the candidates are not NEET-MDS-2025 qualified he or she will not consider for admission in MDS course under Foreign National/ NRI category under any circumstances.

The definition of the terms, "International/Foreign National, Non-resident Indians (NRI)/ and Wards of NRI/Foreign National" be considered as under:-

(1) International/Foreign Nationals (FN):

As per UGC guidelines circulated vide its letter D.O.No.F.1/2022 (CPP-II) dated 30th September, 2022, International/Foreign National students in this context shall be defined as the one who shall possess a foreign passport.

(2) Non-resident Indians: A person shall be deemed to be Non-resident Indian for seeking admission in Panjab University if she/he fulfils the criterion (as amended from time to time) for status of NRI under Income Tax Act, 1961, in the year in which he/she seeks admission in Panjab University. As per Income Tax Act, 1961 the present criterion for determination of status of NRI is as follows:-

'Non-resident Indian' is an individual who is a citizen of India or a person of Indian origin and who is not a resident of India. Thus, in order to determine whether an Individual is a non-resident Indian or not, his residential status is required to be determined under Section 6. As per Section 6 of the Income-tax Act, an individual is said to be non-resident in India if he is not a resident in India and an individual is deemed to be resident in India in any previous year if he satisfies any of the following conditions:-

- (i) If he is in India for a period of 182 days or more during the previous

- year; or
- (ii) If he is in India for a period of 60 days or more during the previous year and 365 days or more during 4 years immediately preceding the previous year.

However, condition No. (ii) does not apply where an individual being citizen of India or a person of Indian origin, who being outside India, comes on a visit to India during the previous year.

A person shall be deemed to be of Indian origin if he, or either of his parents or any of his parents or any of his grand – parents, was born in undivided India.

Wards of Foreign Nationals and NRIs:

A student who seeks admission as a ward of Foreign National or Non-resident Indian should be in a first degree/blood relationship with foreign national or Non resident Indian. The term first degree /blood relationship includes:

- (a) spouse
- (b) children (natural/adopted/foster)
- (c) real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and real aunt
- (d) real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt
- (e) father and mother of father i.e. grand-father and grand-mother
- (f) father and mother of mother i.e. maternal grand-father and maternal grand- mother
- (g) first degree-paternal and maternal cousins of the candidate.

CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

The NRI/Foreign Nationals students shall provide the following certificates/ documents (whichever is applicable):

- 1) Eligibility/equivalency certificate from the Deputy Registrar (General), Panjab University, Chandigarh or Academic certificates of passing the qualifying or equivalent examination approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/Common wealth Universities/International Association of Universities (IAU) as equivalent to the corresponding Indian Degrees/Certificates.
- 2) Copy of Passport/Relevant Documents to claim NRI/Foreign National Seat
- 3) Relevant Documents to be submitted by Wards of NRI
 - a. Proof of relationship of student with Guardian
 - b. Affidavits from the Guardian
 - c. Affidavits from the student
 - d. Undertaking from the Guardian
 - e. Employment proof of the guardian
 - f. Copy of the PR Card/Citizenship proof/ Passport of the guardian (from the country he/she resides)

Eligibility and Admission Criterion:

- (i) The students who will be admitted against the NRI quota should have the basic qualification fixed by the Dental Council of India for admission in Dental courses.

- (ii) A candidate once admitted as NRI candidate in an undergraduate course shall be covered under the definition of NRI for subsequent admission to any course at Panjab University.
- (iii) Candidates who take admission under the NRI quota and are promoted from Undergraduate to Postgraduate course shall not be allowed to change their category.
- (iv) NRI candidates shall have to comply with any other requirements prescribed by the Govt. of India and Panjab University from time to time.
- (v) The **Foreign Nationals and NRI candidates shall provide the following certificates / documents:-**
 - (a) The Foreign National and NRI students wishing to join BDS course of the Panjab University for the first time are required to obtain an eligibility certificate from the **Deputy Registrar (General), Panjab University, Chandigarh** or Academic Certificates of passing the qualifying or equivalent examination approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/ Commonwealth Universities/ International Association of Universities (IAU) as equivalent to the corresponding Indian Degrees/ Certificates.
 - (b) The foreign students admitted are required to fill up Foreign Student Information System (FSIS) Form complete in all respects, along with copies of passport and Visa and submit to the office of Dean International Students, Panjab University, Chandigarh. This form is an urgent requirement of the Foreign Registration Office (FRO), Sector-9, Chandigarh and the candidate has to report to the Foreign Registration Office (FRO) within fourteen days of arrival in Chandigarh, with the number generated after the online submission of this form. Foreign Students Information System (FSIS) is to be submitted by hand by the candidate and the FSIS No. will be issued by this Office personally to the students.
 - (c) Foreign Students Welfare Fee @ Rs.1655/- per student. Each NRI/Foreign Student is required to submit the same in cash, which may be deposited with the 'Extension Counter, State Bank of India, Administrative Block, Panjab University, Chandigarh. Original Receipts of the fee deposited is to be submitted to the office of the Dean International Students along with Registration Form (To be submitted after Confirmation of Admission)

2. Changes, if any, in the Schedule / Counseling etc. shall be notified only through website of the Institute i.e. <https://dentalsciences.puchd.ac.in/show-noticeboard.php?nbid=4>. No candidate shall be informed individually. **Candidates are advised to browse the website regularly for any announcements/changes and the Institute shall not be responsible for any fallout due to lack of information on the part of the candidate.**
3. Candidates must retain the copy of Prospectus & Printed Application Form with them. They should carefully read the instructions, rules & regulations and comply with all instructions therein strictly.
4. The allotment of speciality to the applicants for admission, shall be made by the Admission Committee as per merit determined on the basis of NEET-MDS-2025 and the choice of the speciality opted by the candidate. The allotment of seats will be made online as per the merit as well as the preferred choice of the candidates. Only candidates who are allotted seats as per release of Seat Allotment (Provisional) List for various rounds of Counseling's will be asked to report physically in the Institute to complete the admission formalities. The candidate must bring along all the original documents as well as a set of photocopies of all these aforementioned original documents.
5. The candidate should read the eligibility conditions/ criteria carefully. Just appearing in counseling does not entitle him/her for admission. The eligibility shall be determined by the Admission Committee on the basis of documents submitted by the candidate at the time of reporting. Those who are not eligible as per the decision of the committee will not be considered for admission. The candidates will appear in counseling at their own risk and responsibility. Eligibility is also subject to medical fitness.
6. Before applying for the admission, candidate should ensure that their BDS degree is recognized as per provisions of Dental Council of India. If it is found at any time that BDS degree is not recognized, the candidature/Admission to MDS course shall be cancelled.
7. Original certificates/documents shall have to be deposited by the candidate at the time of reporting, after the seat has been allotted to the candidate. The certificates/documents shall be returned to the candidate only after surrendering the seat or after the completion of the course.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE COUNSELING

1. All eligible candidates will be considered for admission against general category seats according to their rank/merit in the combined list, in addition to the category/categories they have applied for. For this consideration, they must fulfill the cut off criteria for General Category, as prescribed by the Dental Council of India.
2. Merit List for each category will be made separately based on the score of NEET-MDS-2025. Merit list will be displayed on the Institute Notice Board and at Institute Website. Important Admission Formalities

1. The candidates selected for admission will have to undergo medical examination by the constituted Medical Board on the day of reporting. Only those candidates who are found to be medically fit shall be granted admission.
2. The candidates, who do not appear before the Medical Board or are found to be medically unfit, shall not be allowed to join the course.
3. Fee is to be paid on the day of the physical reporting.
