ORAL & MAXILLOFACIAL PATHOLOGY AND ORAL MICROBIOLOGY

The Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Pathology and Oral Microbiology is an integral part of Dr. Harvansh Singh Judge Institute of Dental Sciences & Hospital which is dedicated to advancing knowledge in diagnosing, managing, and preventing oral diseases. Through its comprehensive academic programs, clinical services, research, and dedicated faculty and staff, the department is committed to improving the oral health of our community and advancing the science of oral pathology and microbiology.

Mission: To advance knowledge in oral pathology and oral microbiology and provide exceptional education, research, and clinical care to improve the oral health of our community and beyond.

Vision: To be a leading center for oral pathology and oral microbiology, renowned for our innovative research, groundbreaking clinical applications, and exceptional student training.

The department offers a Master's program since 2017 (with an intake of 3 Postgraduates per academic session) to prepare students for careers in oral health care. It also offers clinical services for Oral Biopsy and Diagnosis by providing a definitive diagnosis of oral lesions, including benign and malignant tumors, and Maxillofacial Pathology by diagnosing diseases affecting the jaws, facial bones, and surrounding tissues. The department is also actively engaged in a wide range of research projects, focusing on improving the diagnostic modalities for oral squamous cell carcinoma; age and gender estimation employing various odontometric and other oral parameters; studying the role of oral microorganisms in oral pathological diseases; and developing new diagnostic tools and technologies for early detection and accurate diagnosis of oral diseases.

DEPARTMENT OF ORTHODONTICS & DENTOFACIAL ORTHOPEDICS

There should be nothing artificial about your smile and orthodontics along with Dentofacial orthopedics does the same. The Department of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopaedics, of Dr. Harvansh Singh Judge Institute of Dental Sciences & Hospital is one of the best Orthodontic departments in the tricity area of Chandigarh, Mohali and Panchkula. One of the major differences in orthodontics speciality viz. other dental specialities is that teeth are not seen as individuals units but as an integral part of the jaw and face scientifically and integral part of personality of an individual, socially.

The department is providing treatment at a very nominal cost despite being located near the heart of the city beautiful Chandigarh. It caters to the patients having problems of irregular teeth, crooked teeth, spacing between teeth, bad bite, cleft lip and palate and also patients having skeletal problems. The department is offering orthodontic treatment by incorporating all the latest methods / techniques available such as PEA (Pre-adjusted Edgewise appliance), Ceramic (aesthetic braces), Self-ligating systems, Clear Aligners therapy (CAT) Lingual (invisible braces), Micro implants and correction of Jaw problems by growth modulation techniques and/or orthographic surgeries as per the individual need.

The department is catering to the patients coming from periphery of tricity area of Chandigarh, Panchkula and Mohali i.e. as far as 30 km radius of Chandigarh. Further, the department has outstation patients as far as from Delhi, Himachal, Haryana and Punjab. At present, the department has more than 1000 running cases of comprehensive orthodontic treatment. Recently department has seen a surge in adult orthodontic cases being reported which speaks volumes about the awareness being present in the surrounding areas.

The department is well equipped with 29 ultra-modern electronically operated dental chairs with light cure units and scalers attached. The department has Hydro soldering unit and Biostar pressure moulding machine for super specialty work. It's been more than 10 years since the department started post-graduation (MDS) in the year 2015 with intake of three students every year. The department has well equipped Cephalometric-tracing area along with Nemoceph software for treatment planning, fully audiovisual ready seminar room cum department library, PG common room and systematic record maintenance zone including readily retrievable digital photographs, study models and radiographs of the patients. Being part of Panjab University, the students can also, take advantage of Interdisciplinary research by collaborating with various other departments of universities more so by utilizing state of art equipment and infrastructure available pan university. Further, the department is providing teaching/clinical training to 100 BDS undergraduate student every year, for which the department has best of infrastructure (spacious & well-equipped lecture theatres, orthodontic laboratories and library with internet facility) in the entire region. Lectures are taken with Audio visual aids and constant encouragement for participation in projects pertaining to the subject elsewhere.

The department faculty has high level of publications profile including a patent and copyright grant from Government of India. The faculty strength is further augmented by an Honorary Professor who has been Ex-Chairman of Oral Health Sciences Center of premier institute Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research.

DEPARTMENT OF PERIODONTICS

Overview

The Department of Periodontics at Panjab University has distinct undergraduate and postgraduate sections, both equipped with modern dental chairs featuring ultrasonic scalers in accordance with Dental Council of India guidelines. Undergraduate students are trained in non-surgical and preventive periodontal techniques, with exposure to surgical procedures through observation and assistance during treatments. Postgraduate students are provided with the opportunity to learn and master a range of surgical clinical procedures. As part of the MDS curriculum, practical training in various implant systems, along with clinical exposure to laser use and microsurgical equipment, is also incorporated.

Key Features

- Advanced surgical equipments like Laser unit, microsurgical unit, electrocautery unit, and centrifuge to procure PRF, implant unit are the additional facilities available in the department.
- Advanced research facilities like PCR, anaerobic chamber, ELISA,CBCT, systems are also available at the institutional level. Few more sophisticated research equipment(Gel Electrophoresis, with power pack, Gradient PCR unit) has been sanctioned to the department from central grants viz SERB, which are further value additions to the institute as a whole.
- The institute is a member of 'CRICK' unit of Panjab university and has multiple inter institute collaborations including IMTECH,PGIMER,GMCH-32 with ongoing projects from Periodontology department. It is one of the spokes in the MHRD sectioned "Design Innovation Centre" of university, with the focused research on the development and testing of biomedical devices. Additionally there are in house inter departmental collaborations with the microbiology, biotechnology, biochemistry and biophysics departments of Panjab University to provide a broader research avenues.
- An MOU with the Central Instruments Laboratory (CIL) and Sophisticated Analytical Instrumentation Facility (SAIF) provides an in-house platform for conducting TEM, SEM, Mass Spectrometry, NMR, electron microscope, and Field Emission Scanning Electron Microscope.
- The department is credit with research funding worth 26,655,000 /- from various research project grants, which sums to equivalent to approximately 90% of the total funding of the institute.

Faculty

The entire faculty (7 members) is involved in teaching undergraduate and post graduate students. The faculty is highly experienced with an experience over 15-25 years along with nine postgraduates at present. Currently, two faculty members have completed PhD course at UGC approved universities. Faculty members are also members of board of studies and various college committees. Some of them are examiners for national and international universities. Many are active members of ISP holding key posts presently or in the past. Two of the faculty members are fellows of International College of Dentists. The faculty members have, in their credit, more than 200 publications in various national and International indexed journals with high impact Factor. Many of the departmental projects have been funded by Government bodies viz ICMR,SERB, DST and industry grants from oral health care sectors e.g. waterpik,Orthogen. Some of the areas of research interest are:

- Regeneration of soft and hard tissues
- Periodontal Medicine
- Microbiology
- Implants
- Periopathogenesis at molecular level
- Local drug Delivery
- Preventive and nonsurgical periodontal Therapy
- Perio-aesthetic surgeries

Activities and Events

A variety of events and conferences have been organized at the departmental level over time. Most recently, the department hosted the 47th ISP National Conference from December 1-3, 2023, at the GNDU auditorium in Amritsar. The conference attracted over 1,500 delegates from across the country, with scientific presentations from five international periodontology associations being a major highlight of the event. Notable past events include the 22nd ISP PG National Convention 2022 in Chandigarh, the 37th National Annual ISP Conference in Shimla, the Indo-US Bilateral Workshop on 21st Century Developments in Bone Regeneration, CHASCON 2024, the National Seminar on Clinical Dentistry (an annual institutional event), the 2nd ISP Colloquium 2015, and the ISP Perio Integrate event with hands-on workshops on Implants, Lasers, and Piezo Surgery. Additionally, the Department of Periodontology, in collaboration with the Department of Public Health Dentistry, has been actively involved in organizing special events such as Oral Hygiene Day, Oral Health Day, and Dentist's Day.

STUDENT PERSPECTIVES

The Department of Periodontics is one of the best places to do one's postgraduation in the subject. The department has a robust case load along with a research-centric approach which encompasses both clinical and basic science-related tracks. The department has research collaborations with other institutes in the region which blends well with the science of Periodontics and grants students the opportunity to conduct research at a level probably not possible in most parts of the country. Overall, the department has the resources available in terms of clinical work, faculty competence and collaborations to set the student up for a meaningful career in Periodontics.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The admission to MDS course shall be open to candidates who have qualified NEET-MDS 2026 and are eligible as per eligibility criteria for NEET-MDS 2026 laid down in Information Bulletin for National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test-MDS for admission to MDS course 2026. This is applicable for all applicants irrespective all their status (Indian/Foreign National/NRI).
2. As per National Dental Commission (erstwhile Dental Council of India) guidelines, the minimum percentile of marks to be eligible for admission to postgraduate dental courses shall be 50% percentile for General Category & NRI candidates, 45% percentile for Person with Disability (PwD) and 40% percentile for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/ Backward Classes (BC).
3. Counseling / Admission shall be conducted by the Admission Committee constituted by the Panjab University for this purpose.
4. Candidates cannot claim a seat/admission on the basis of the NEET-MDS-2026rank alone. Eligibility of a candidate for admission against any Post Graduate seat will be determined by the Admission Committee, as per rules and regulations laid down by the Panjab University & National Dental Commission (erstwhile Dental Council of India) from time to time. The eligibility shall also be based on other documents as specified in the check list on page No. 29.
5. In case any candidate is found to have furnished false information or certificate, etc. or is found to have withheld or concealed information in his/her Admission Form, he/she shall be debarred from admission.
6. In case any candidate surrenders a seat, he/she will not be eligible to attend subsequent admission counselings for the MDS course in the University in the same year.
7. All eligible candidates including own merit candidates from reserved categories will be considered for admission against general category seats according to their rank/merit in the combined list (as per merit criteria for General Category), in addition to the category/categories they have applied for.
8. For claims on reserved seats/categories wherever applicable, the candidates must support their claim by bringing original documents on the date of counselling (point No. 6 of the counseling schedule) self-attested photocopy of appropriate certificate(s)/ documents issued by competent authority as per specimen given in Annexures to this Prospectus.
9. **The candidate shall not be allowed to make any change(s) in the Category as**

well as in the Online Application Form, once submitted, by way of any addition/ deletion/ alteration/ amendment etc. of any type under any circumstance.

10. Candidate with disability, i.e., Person with Disability (PwD) shall be considered for admission as per rules and regulations specified by National Dental Commission as appended below:-

“5% seats of the annual sanctioned intake capacity shall be filled up by candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs in between 50% to 70%.

Provided that in case any seat in this 5% quota remains unfilled on account of unavailability of candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% then any such unfilled seat in this 5% quota shall be filled up by persons with locomotory disability of lower limbs between 40% to 50% before they are included in the annual sanctioned seats for General Category candidates”.

11. Eligibility Criteria for Foreign National/ NRI Students

Only NEET (MDS)-2026 qualified candidates (not less than 50th Percentile) can apply for admission against NRI Category seats for admission year 2026.

A foreign national may seek admission in MDS being offered by the University through Office of the Dean International Students, Panjab University, Chandigarh as per the guidelines/ terms & Conditions available at the website of <https://www.dis.puchd.ac.in/> provided that such candidates should be NEET-MDS-2026 qualified.

Notwithstanding any conditions laid down at <https://www.dis.puchd.ac.in> if the candidates who are not NEET-MDS-2026 qualified, he or she will not consider for admission in MDS course under Foreign National/ NRI category under any circumstances.

IMPORTANT

As per new guidelines issued by Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, it is mandatory for all foreign students to first register on Study in India (SII) website & generates a Unique SII ID to initiate admission process.

This SII ID will be the main tracking ID for foreign students for their complete student journey.

Students will be granted Student visa and E-student Visa, only if they have unique SII ID.

If a student has paid fees to the institute and the institute has updated the same on SII website, then the foreign student is eligible for E-student Visa as well.

The Institute's confirmation of the student's fee payment supports the visa verification process, without which student might not be granted the visa.

MHA can verify the foreign student's details via their SII ID by logging into their BOI Module on SII website.

- **Foreign National students** with nomination/sponsorship by any Foreign State, Embassy or Authority in India/Ministry of Govt. of India under a Study in India/Exchange Programme, etc. may apply for admission to Panjab University through ICCR website subject to the condition that the student is eligible to seek admission as per the regulations of the course.

The definition of the terms, "International/Foreign National, Non-resident Indians (NRI)/ and Wards of NRI/Foreign National" be considered as under:-

(1) International/Foreign Nationals (FN):

As per UGC guidelines circulated vide its letter D.O.No.F.1/2022 (CPP-II) dated 30th September, 2022, International/Foreign National students in this context shall be defined as the one who shall possess a foreign passport.

(2) Non-resident Indians (NRI):

A person shall be deemed to be Non-resident Indian for seeking admission in Panjab University if she/he fulfils the criterion (as amended from time to time) for status of NRI under Income Tax Act, 1961, in the year in which he/she seeks admission in Panjab University.

As per Income Tax Act, 1961 the present criterion for determination of status NRI is as follows

'Non-resident Indian' is an individual who is a citizen of India or a person of Indian origin and who is not a resident of India. Thus, in order to determine whether an Individual is a non-resident Indian or not, his residential status is required to be determined under Section 6. As per Section 6 of the Income-tax Act, an individual is said to be non-resident in India if he is not a resident in India and an individual is deemed to be resident in India in any previous year if he satisfies any of the following conditions: -

- (i) If he is in India for a period of 182 days or more during the previous year; or
- (ii) If he is in India for a period of 60 days or more during the previous year and 365 days or more during 4 years immediately preceding the previous year.

However, condition No. (ii) does not apply where an individual being citizen of India or a person of Indian origin, who being outside India, comes on a visit to India during the previous year.

OR

- A person shall be deemed to be of Indian origin if he, or either of his parents or any of his parents or any of his grand-parents, was born in undivided India.

OR

- Indian Nationals who have completed their last qualifying programme outside India.

OR

- Indian Nationals who have acquired NRI status and holding it for the last three years after obtaining an undergraduate degree from India.

OR

- A person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or Foreign Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:

- (i) For or on taking up employment outside India; or
- (ii) For carrying on a business or vocation outside India; or
- (iii) For any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;

(3) Ward of NRI/FN

A student who seeks admission as a ward of Foreign National or Nonresident Indian should be in a first degree/blood relationship with foreign national/OCI/PIO or Non-resident Indian. The term first degree /blood relationship includes:

Spouse/Father or mother of the Candidate/Siblings/Paternal or maternal Grandparents

GENERAL RULES FOR NRI/FOREIGN NATIONAL STUDENTS

1. A student admitted under NRI/Wards of FN/NRI quota may change his/her admission to a vacant seat in General /Reserved Category provided the student qualifies the Entrance Test **(if prescribed for the respective course)** and the merit of the student falls within the list of students admitted in General/Reserve Category.
2. Student once admitted under NRI/FN category to undergraduate course shall be

covered under the definition of NRI/FN for subsequent admission to any course at Panjab University.

3. NRI/FN students shall also have to comply with any other requirements prescribed by the Govt. of India and Panjab University from time to time.
4. Order of preference to determine merit for admission against NRI seats in departments/Centres/ Institutions where NRI seats are reserved out of total sanctioned strength.
 - a) **Foreign National**
 - b) **NRI**
 - c) **Ward of NRI/FN**

ELIGIBILITY AND ADMISSION CRITERION

- (i) The students who will be admitted against the NRI quota should have the basic qualification fixed by the National Dental Commission (erstwhile Dental Council of India) for admission in Dental courses.
- (ii) A candidate once admitted as NRI candidate in an postgraduate course shall be covered under the definition of NRI for subsequent admission to any course.
- (iii) The NRI/Foreign Nationals students wishing to join any of the University Teaching Departments of Panjab University for the first time are required to obtain an eligibility/equivalency certificate from the Deputy Registrar (General), Panjab University, Chandigarh or Academic certificates of passing the qualifying or equivalent examination approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/Common wealth Universities/International Association of Universities (IAU) as equivalent to the corresponding Indian Degrees/Certificates.
- (iv) After obtaining the Eligibility Certificate, the candidates must submit alongwith online application to MDS course.

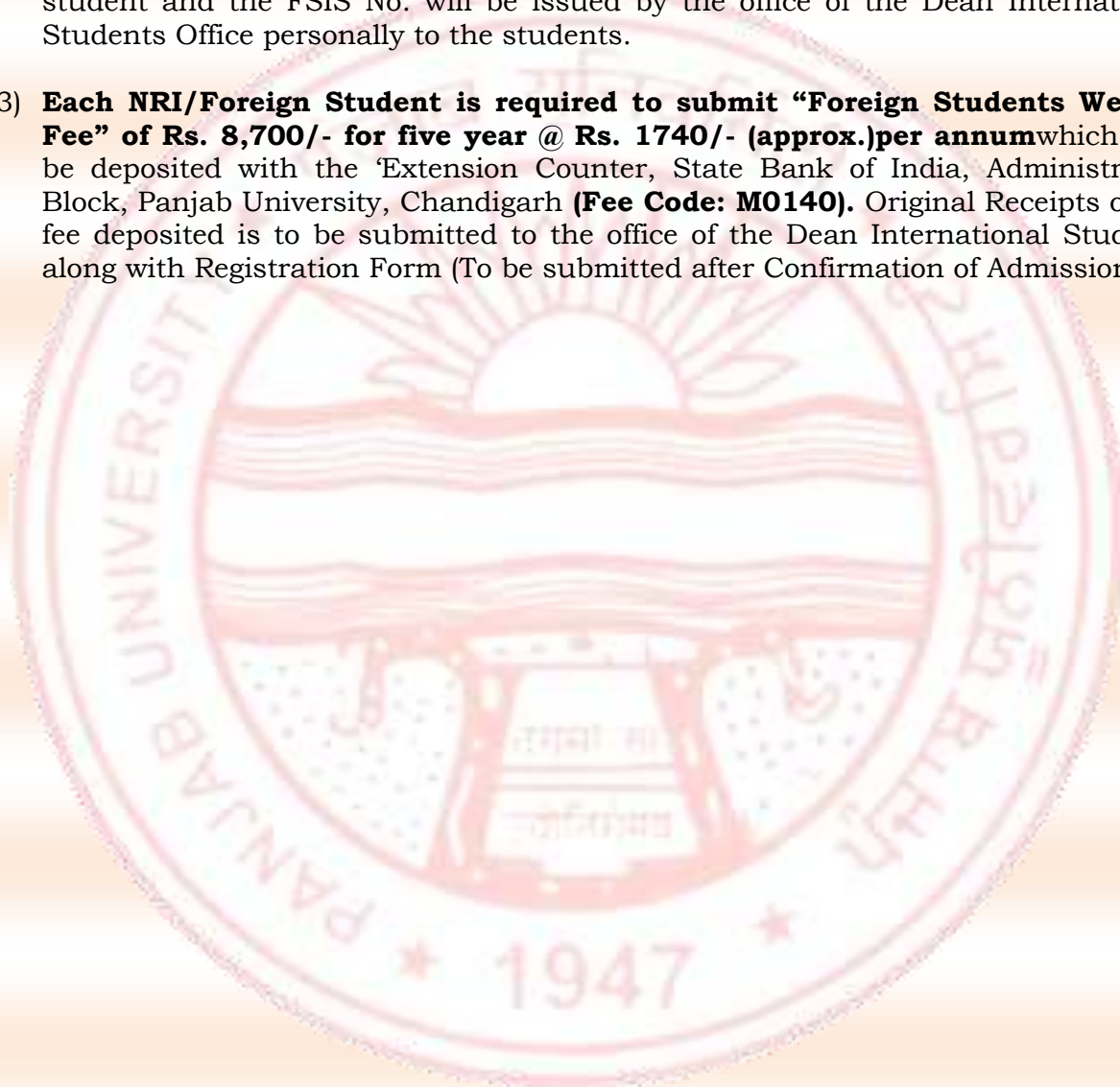
CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

The NRI/Foreign Nationals students shall provide the following certificates/documents (whichever is applicable):

- 1) Eligibility/equivalency certificate from the Deputy Registrar (General), Panjab University, Chandigarh or Academic certificates of passing the qualifying or equivalent examination approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/Common wealth Universities/International Association of Universities (IAU) as equivalent to the corresponding Indian Degrees/Certificates.
- 2) Copy of Passport/Relevant Documents to claim NRI/Foreign National Seat.
- 3) Relevant Documents to be submitted by Wards of NRI
 - a. Proof of relationship of student with Guardian
 - b. Affidavits from the Guardian
 - c. Affidavits from the student
 - d. Undertaking from the Guardian
 - e. Employment proof of the guardian
 - f. Copy of the PR Card/Citizenship proof/ Passport of the guardian (from the country he/she resides)
 - g. All documents as applicable for eligible candidates of General category.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED AFTER CONFORMATION OF ADMISSION

- 1) The Foreign National students admitted are required to fill up Foreign Student Information System (FSIS) Form complete in all respects, along with copies of passport and Visa and submit to the office of Dean International Students, Panjab University, Chandigarh. This form is an urgent requirement of the Foreign Registration Office (FRO), Sector-9, Chandigarh and the student has to report to the Foreign Registration Office (FRO) within fourteen days of arrival in Chandigarh, with the number generated after the online submission of this form.(<https://indianfro.gov.in/eservices/home.jsp>)
- 2) Foreign Students Information System (FSIS) is to be submitted by hand by the student and the FSIS No. will be issued by the office of the Dean International Students Office personally to the students.
- 3) **Each NRI/Foreign Student is required to submit “Foreign Students Welfare Fee” of Rs. 8,700/- for five year @ Rs. 1740/- (approx.)per annum** which may be deposited with the ‘Extension Counter, State Bank of India, Administrative Block, Panjab University, Chandigarh **(Fee Code: M0140)**. Original Receipts of the fee deposited is to be submitted to the office of the Dean International Students along with Registration Form (To be submitted after Confirmation of Admission).

The allotment of speciality to the applicants for admission, shall be made by the Admission Committee as per merit determined on the basis of NEET-MDS-2026 and the choice of the speciality opted by the candidate. **Physical presence is mandatory in every counseling both for General Category and Reserved Categories candidates as per the notified dates.** The candidate must bring along all the original documents as well as a set of photocopies of all these aforementioned original documents.
5. The candidate should read the eligibility conditions/ criteria carefully. Just appearing in counseling does not entitle him/her for admission. The eligibility shall be determined by the Admission Committee on the basis of documents submitted by the candidate at the time of reporting. Those who are not eligible as per the decision of the committee will not be considered for admission. The candidates will appear in counseling at their own risk and responsibility. Eligibility is also subject to medical fitness.
6. Before applying for the admission, candidate should ensure that their BDS degree is recognized as per provisions of National Dental Commission (erstwhile Dental Council of India). If it is found at any time that BDS degree is not recognized, the candidature/Admission to MDS course shall be cancelled.
7. **Original certificates/documents shall have to be deposited by the candidate at the time of counseling, after the seat has been allotted to the candidate. The certificates/documents shall be returned to the candidate only after surrendering the seat or after the completion of the course.**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PHYSICAL COUNSELING

1. All eligible candidates will be considered for admission against general category seats according to their rank/merit in the combined list, in addition to the category/categories they have applied for. For this consideration, they must fulfill the cut off criteria for General Category, as prescribed by the National Dental Commission (erstwhile Dental Council of India).
2. Merit List for each category will be made separately based on the score of NEET-MDS-2026. Merit list will be displayed on the Institute Notice Board and at Institute Website. Information regarding any changes in the schedule or details of counselings shall be notified on the Institute website <https://dentalsciences.puchd.ac.in/show-noticeboard.php?nbid=4>. No individual/separate intimation will be provided by the Institute office for the same. NRI candidate fee shall be payable in the form of Bank Draft in US dollar/ Pounds, Sterling/ Deutschmark or equivalent amount in Indian Currency payable to the “REGISTRAR, PANJAB UNIVERSITY, CHANDIGARH” (payable at Chandigarh) **ALONG WITH A BANK CERTIFICATE FOR ENCASHMENT OF FOREIGN CURRENCY OF THE LIKE AMOUNT.**

B. The fee to be charged is subject to revision by Panjab University Authorities and amendment from time to time and the revised decision will be applicable irrespective of that given in this prospectus.

- 7. A monthly stipend of Rs.13,900/- shall be paid to the students for the three years duration of the course from the date of joining.**
8. In the Reserved Categories of SC/ST, the seats shall be regarded as 'Interchangeable'. That is to say, if sufficient numbers of eligible candidates are not available to fill up the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes the same may be filled up from amongst the eligible candidates belonging to the Scheduled Tribes and vice-versa.
9. Important Admission Formalities

1. The candidates selected for admission will have to undergo medical examination by the constituted Medical Board on the day of reporting. Only those candidates who are found to be medically fit shall be granted admission.
2. The candidates, who do not appear before the Medical Board or are found to be medically unfit, shall not be allowed to join the course.
3. Fee is to be paid on the day of the physical counselling. 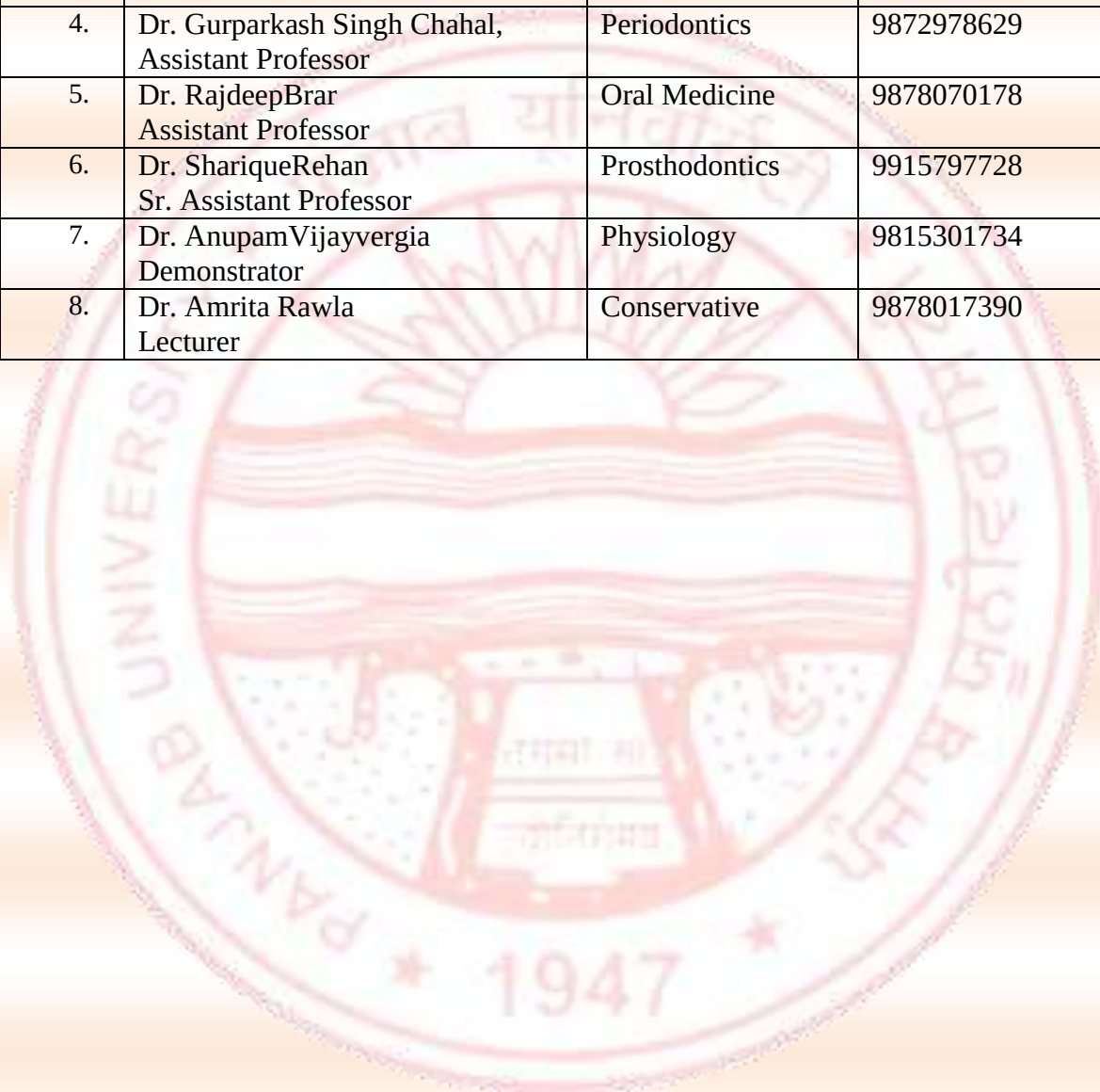
